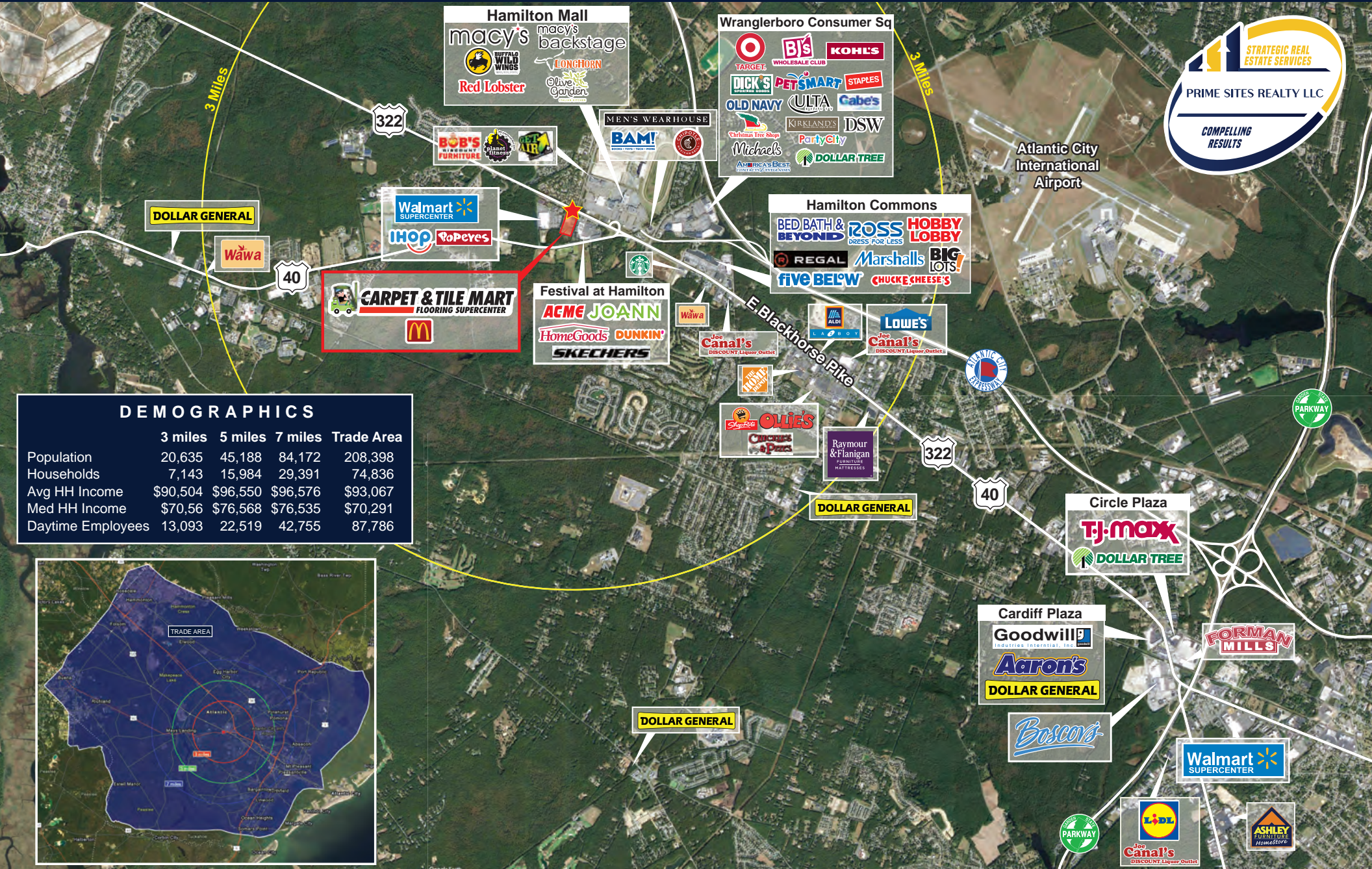

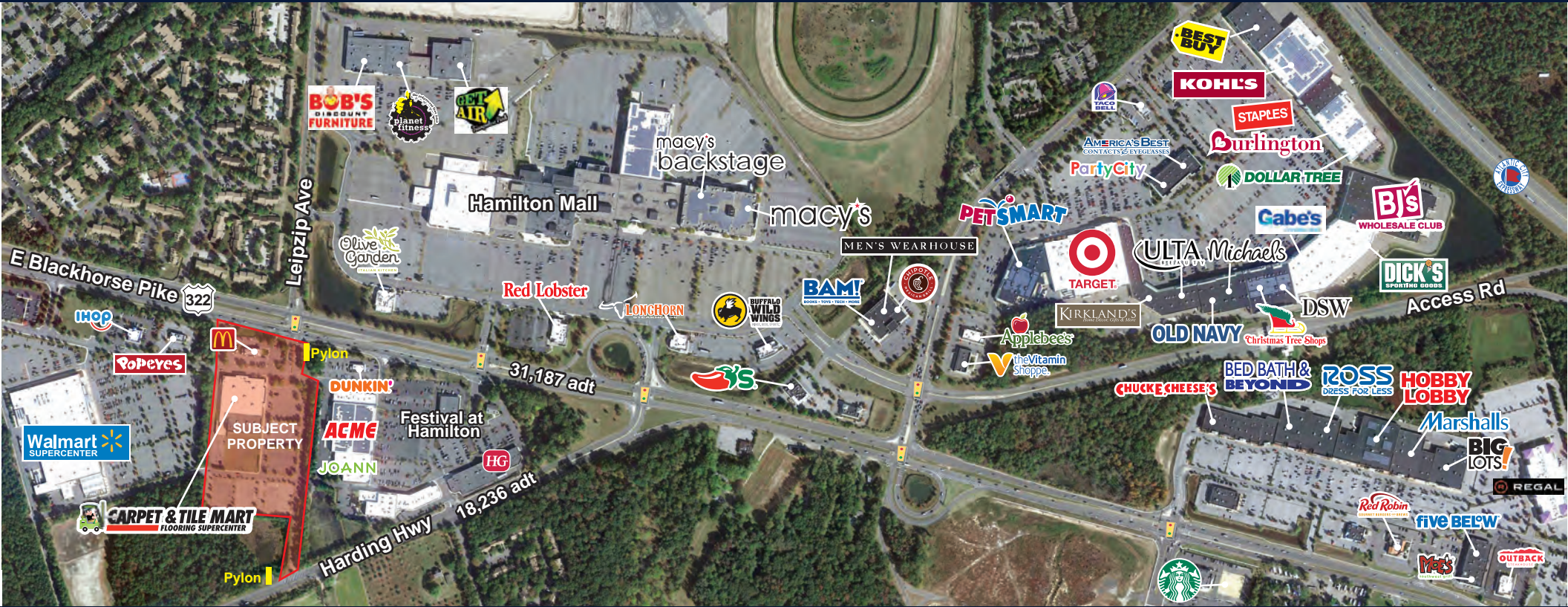

The five-year projection for the population in the area is 21,147 representing a change of 0.49% annually from 2021 to 2026. Currently, the population is 49.7% male and 50.3% female.
